CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES: June 12, 2024 Regular Meeting Open Session Minutes: The Board reviewed the June 12, 2024 regular meeting minutes. TREASURER'S REPORT: June 30, 2024 Treasurer's Report: The Board reviewed the Treasurer's Report for the period ending June 30, 2024. As of June 1, 2024 the District's beginning balance was \$6,416,388.56. The District received deposits during the month of June in the amount of \$173,883.90. The June expenses totaled (\$363,558.97). The June in-and-out transfers were \$832,705.27. The June net balance change was (\$189,675.07).
